**AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY
PAPERWORK TO HAVE SHARON TOWNSHIP JOIN
THE MID-OHIO REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Sharon Township Board of Trustees recognizes the need for collaborative, cooperative planning in order to ensure continued growth and prosperity;

WHEREAS, the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission's Mission Statement indicates it is "The regional voice and a catalyst for sustainability and economic prosperity in order to secure a competitive advantage for central Ohio;"

WHEREAS, the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission currently includes over 90 local governments and has for over 60 years addressed challenges and opportunities associated with growth and development in central Ohio, as well as working with its members to improve the quality of life within the region; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes it would be advantageous for Sharon Township to join the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission and to take advantage of the opportunities provided within that organization as a means of benefitting the citizens of Sharon Township.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees agrees to enter into the Articles of Agreement of the Commission and established Bylaws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sharon Township Board of Trustees:

SECTION ONE: The Fiscal Officer is authorized to execute necessary documentation and to remit the membership dues to join the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission. Furthermore, the Board of Trustees hereby appoints Trustee Kunze as their representative to the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission.

SECTION TWO: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force effective immediately after its passage.
