PERS Says Deduction Payment Late

Franklin County Penalized \$5820

Penalties totaling \$5820.69 have been levied against Franklin County by the Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) because the county missed a payment deadline by two days.

County Auditor Arch Warren was notified of the penalty by Fred L. Schneider, executive director of PERS. Warren said he was unable to have the penalty remitted. He said Schneider told him the penalty was statutory.

THE LATE payment involved deductions for county employes and employees of the County Health Department for the period ending

Nov. 30. The payment was made to PERS Feb. 1.

The law involved says a five per cent penalty is added if payments are made "60 or more days after the last day of the reporting period." It is the first time the county has been more than 60 days late in filing a report.

WARREN SAID he did not know why the payment was late, other than "We've been scraping the bottom of the barrel to get our bills paid and it's often a case of robbing Peter to pay Paul." He

blamed it partially on a case of "first-of-the-year-itis."

He said he did not believe the tardiness worked a hardship on anyone because PERS "has got more money than Rockefeller's got."

SCHNEIDER urged the county to immediately make its report because "reports that are not submitted promptly delay processing and paying new retirement benefits."

The county borrowed \$1.5 million at the beginning of the year to pay bills until the present tax collection came

in. Real estate tax payments are due by Feb. 22.

CHIEF DEPUTY Auditor Arthur Marland said the loan was used to meet the county payroll and to pay the county's share of welfare costs.

Marland said he would look into the failure to pay the PERS funds on time. It is not known now whether the funds were available to make the payment on time or whether the late payment was the result of an oversight in the auditor's office.

Marland said the county was notified the PERS payment was due and "we paid it right away."


