Clerk administered oath of office to trustees Carl O. Knost and Paul R. Insley.

The financial report as of January 1, 1978 was submitted reviewed and approved as submitted.

Clerk asked for nominations for Chairman of the Board for 1978. Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that Paul R. Insley be Chairman for the year 1978. All voted "Aye" thereon. Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Insley, that John D. Loomis serve as vice-Chairman for the year 1978. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Trustees set the first and third Wednesday evening of each month, at 7:30 p.m. as the regular meeting nights.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Insley, that Mr. Knost be appointed to serve as the township member to the Walnut Grove Cemetery Association Board. All voted "Aye" thereon. Other members are: Richard T. Savage, council; and James Charlton, member at large.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Knost, that Mr. Knost and Mr. Insley be appointed to serve on the Volunteer Firemen's Dependents Fund Board and the Firemen's Pension Fund Board. All voted "Aye" thereon. The two firemen serving on this board are Elwood Grazer (Chairman) and Jerry Wellman (Sec.) the fourth man elected as the non partisan member is Norman Lehman. All are appointed for a one year term.

Chairman Insley is to represent Sharon Township on the Franklin County Board of Health.

Clerk reported that the Ohio State Association of Township Trustees and Clerks Convention will be held January 18-21st at the Columbus Sheraton Motor Hotel. Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Knost, that expenses to and from the convention and auto parking be paid by the township for trustees and clerk if they should attend. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that the vapor lights at Highview at #315 and at Clubview at #315 be paid through 1978. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that the mileage rate of 15¢ per mile be set, All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that the trustees compensation be set at the \$22.00 per day per diem rate set by law. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that the clerks compensation be set at the \$6,000.00 per year as determined by law. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that Lois Johnson be paid \$5.00 per hour for clerical work done, that she be given two weeks vacation which can be accumulated as requested for 6-8 weeks vacation in 1981, paid holidays, and sick leave as all other township employees. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Clerk reported that the Public Employees Retirement System rate for 1978 is 8.5% and the Firemen's Pension rate is 7%.

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Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that the clerk be paid \$100.00 per quarter for the cleaning of the township hall. All voted "Aye" thereon.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio that:

Harold L. Chandler be re-employed as Sharon Township Road Supt. and Flint Cemetery Supt., that his compensation be set at \$7,151.64 per year. Base being 20 hours for his duties as Road Supt. (10 hrs.) and Flint Cemetery Supt. (10 hrs.) The other 20 hours per week are to be paid by Walnut Grove Cemetery. That he be authorized to employ emergency help for grass cutting or snow removal as he sees fit. All other permanent employees are to be hired by the Sharon Township Trustees. Cost of living to be given quarterly.

James L. Messenger be re-employed with the hourly rate set at \$5.45, that he receive a 3 week vacation with pay and at the discretion of the Road. Supt. and approval of the Board.

Earl R. Hesson be re-employed with an hourly rate of \$5.14, that he receive a two week vacation with pay and at the discretion of the Road Supt. and approval of the Board.

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Carl O. Knost moved the adoption of the following Resolution and John D. Loomis seconded its adoption: "Authorized The Borrowing Of Money In Anticipation Of The Collection Of Taxes By Sharon Township."

WHEREAS, The County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as Secretary of the Budget Commission of said County, has certified that the amount estimated to be received by the Sharon Township Trustees in and for the fiscal year 1978 by way of taxes levied by said Township upon the duplicate thereof, from the next ensuing semi-annual settlement of taxes for the fiscal year 1978 as estimated by the Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio, by the Sharon Township Trustees, other than taxes to be received for the payment of debt charges and all advances will be \$ : and,

WHEREAS, This Board of Sharon Township Trustees deems it necessary to borrow in anticipation of the collection of said taxes in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, particularly Section 133.30, the amount up to \$60,000.00 which is less than one-half of the estimated amount of taxes receivable from the next ensuing semi-annual settlement of taxes for the fiscal year 1978 as estimated by the Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio, by the Township, other than taxes to be received for the payment of debt charges and all advances; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Sharon Township Trustees of the County of Franklin and State of Ohio;

SECTION 1-That in anticipation of the collection of current taxes in and for the fiscal year 1978, levied by said Board of Sharon Township Trustees upon the duplicate of the Township, it is necessary to borrow and there shall be borrowed an amount up to \$60,000.00, which borrowing shall be evidenced by a note or notes of this Sharon Township Trustees Board. Said note or notes shall be dated January 16, 1978, shall bear interest at the rate of 4 3/4% annum, payable at maturity, and shall mature on June 30, 1978. The principal and interest of said note or notes shall be payable at the Ohio State Bank of Columbus, Ohio.

SECTION 2-For the payment and interest of said note or notes, the current taxes of the Township in and for the fiscal year 1978 are hereby appropriated, and the full faith and credit of the Sharon Township Trustees of the Township are hereby irrevocably pledged therefor.

SECTION 3-Said Board of Township Trustees does hereby determine and declare that the total amount of said note or notes hereby authorized does not exceed one-half of the amount of the estimated amount of taxes receivable from the next ensuing semi-annual settlement of taxes, in accordance with Section 133.30, RCO, for the fiscal year 1978 as estimated by the Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio, by the Township. other than taxes to be received for the payment of debt charges and all advances, prior to the date of issuance of said note.

SECTION 4-The Chairman and Clerk of this Board by, and they are hereby authorized and instructed to execute and deliver the note or notes evidencing the borrowing.

SECTION 5-The Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of Franklin County.
