Trustee Paul R. Insley administered the oath of office for Clerk Eleanor Bierly and Trustee John D. Loomis.

Clerk called the meeting to order.

Clerk asked for nominations for Chairman of the Board for 1976 year.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Insley that Carl O. Knost serve as Chairman of Sharon Township Trustees, all voted "Aye" thereon.

The December 17, 1975 Minutes were read and approved.

Clerk submitted the 1975 Financial report.

Trustees set the first and third Wednesday evening of each month, at 7:30 P.M. as the regular meeting nights.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Insley that Mr. Knost be appointed to serve as the township member to Walnut Grove Cemetery Association. Each member serves a two year term. All voted "Aye" thereon. Other members are: from council, Richard T. Savage; member at large, James Charlton.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis, that Mr. Insley and Mr. Loomis be appointed to serve on the Volunteer Firemen's Dependents Fund Board and the Firemen's Pension Fund Board. All voted "Aye" thereon. The two firemen serving on this board are William Oden (Chairman) and Jerry Wellman (Secretary) the four men elected as the non partisan member is Norman Lehman.

Chairman Carl O. Knost is to represent Sharon Township Trustees on the Franklin County Board of Health.

Clerk reported that the Ohio State Association of Township Trustees and Clerk Convention will be held January 21, 22, 23 and 24th 1975, at the Sheraton Columbus Motor Hotel, Columbus, Ohio. Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Knost, that all expenses to and from the convention and auto parking be paid by the township for any trustee and the clerk that could attend. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Insley, that the clerk's compensation be set at the base of \$ plus 3% of all expenditures in excess of the \$6,000.00 as set by law for the fiscal year 1976. That the clerk's bond be renewed, recorded and mailed to the Franklin County Auditor's office. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Insley, that Lois Johnson, clerical help, be increased to \$4.00 per hour for duties assisting the clerk. All voted "Aye" thereon.



WHEREAS, an election was held in Sharon Township on the 5th day of November, 1974, upon the question of levying an additional tax for fire protection purposes at a rate not to exceed one-half mill for each one dollar of valuation of which election due notice was given according to law and at which election the requisite majority of the electors voting on said proposition voted in favor thereof; and

WHEREAS, Sharon Township has purchased a fire truck from Sutphen Company for a price of \$228,190.20 of which \$57,047.00 has been paid in cash, \$51,143.20 is on hand and payable forthwith, leaving a balance of \$120,000.00 presently payable which sum the Board desires to borrow in anticipation of the collection of said voted tax levies.

WHEREAS, it is now deemed necessary to issue and sell \$120,000.00 notes of said Sharon Township under authority of Section 505.37 of the Revised Code of Ohio and to levy and appropriate the aforesaid taxes outside the ten mill limitation to pay the principal and interest of such notes as the same becomes due; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, that for the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of acquiring a fire truck, there shall be issued and sold notes of said Township under authority of Section 505.37 of the Revised Code of Ohio, in the principal sum of \$120,000.00.

Said notes shall be dated the 15th day of March, 1976, shall be serial and shall be numbered 1 and 2, both inclusive, and shall be in the denomination of \$60,000.00 each. They shall bear interest at the rate of four and three-fourths per cent (4-3/4%) per annum, payable annually on the 15th day of March in each of the years 1977 and 1978, until the principal sum is paid. Both principal and interest of said notes shall be payable at the main office of the Huntington National Bank of Columbus as the same become due and respectively mature.

Said notes shall be due and payable as follows: \$60,000 on the 15th day of March in each of the years 1977 and 1978, both inclusive, and shall be subject to call for redemption prior to maturity at the option of the Board.

For the payment of said notes and the interest thereon the full faith, credit and revenue of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio is hereby irrevocably pledged, and for the purpose of providing the necessary funds to pay the interest on the foregoing issue of notes, promptly when and as the same falls due, and also

to provide a fund sufficient to discharge the said notes at maturity, there shall be and is hereby levied on all the taxable property in said Township, in addition to all other taxes a direct tax annually outside the ten mill limitation to the limit of said one mill additional levy approved by the electors at the November 7, 1972 election and to the limit of said one-half mill additional levy approved by the electors of the November 5, 1974 election during the period said notes are to run in an amount sufficient to provide funds to pay interest upon said notes as and when the same falls due and also to provide a fund for the discharge of the principal of said notes at maturity, which tax shall not be less than the interest and sinking fund tax required by Section 11 of Article Xii of the Ohio Constitution and Section 505.37 of the Revised Code of Ohio. Said principal and interest may also be payable from other lawfully available and appropriated funds of said Township at the option of the Board. Said tax shall be, and is hereby ordered computed, certified, levied and extended upon the tax duplicate and collected by the same officers, in the same manner and at the same time that taxes for general purposes for each of said years are certified, levied, extended and collected. Said tax shall be placed before and in preference to all other items and for the full amount thereof. The funds derived from said tax levies hereby required shall be placed in a separate and distinct fund, which, together with all interest collected on the same, shall be irrevocably pledged for the payment of the interest and principal of said notes, when and as the same fall due.

Said notes shall express upon their face the purpose for which they are issued; that they are issued pursuant to this RESOLUTION and shall be signed by the members of the Board of Township Trustees and attested by the Clerk of Sharon Township.

IT is hereby determined that all acts, conditions and things necessary to be done precedent to and in the issuance of said notes in order to make the same legal, valid and binding obligations of said Township have been done, have happened and been performed in regular and due form as required by law and that the tax for the payment of the principal and interest as the same falls due does not exceed any limitations of taxation of said Township, and that the amount of this bond issue does not exceed any limitation of indebtedness as fixed by law.


