The first meeting of the year 1963 was called to order by the township clerk.

The December 12th, 19th, 27th minutes were read and approved. Clerk asked for nominations from the floor for the 1963 Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Knost that Melvin L. Thomas serve as Chairman of the Sharon Township Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Carl O. Knost serve as Vice-Chairman of the Sharon Township Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Trustees set the first and third Wednesday of each month at Sharon Township Hall, time 7:30 P.M. as the regular meeting nights.

The Ohio State Convention of Township Trustees & Clerks will be held January 23, 24, 25th, 1963. Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Knost that all expenses to and from and during the convention plus garage expenses be paid. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by The Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio:

That, Orban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance be re-employed and designated as Police Constables for Sharon Township.

That the compensation of Constable Barker be set at \$4,200.00 per year, \$350.00 per month, payable on the 1st and 15th of each month for keeping the peace and protecting the property and performing the duties as a police constable, to have a two weeks vacation with pay, and have a \$1,000.00 Police Constable Bond, that radio maintenance and purchase of uniforms be paid by township subject to approval from the Board of Trustees.

Fire Chief, L. F. Sanford reported on all fire department matters, submitted Fire Department Inventory, which is placed on file.

Trustees and Fire Chief discussed salaries and wages for the fire department and firemen.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Harold A. Morgan be re-employed for 1963, as the Sharon Township Fire Station Custodian, that the custodian be compensated ~~225.00~~ ^{same} 225.00 per month payable 1st and 15th of each month; that he have two weeks vacation with pay; that the custodian obtain a reliable person to take charge during this two week vacation period for \$100.00; that he employ the custodian relief one day per week not to exceed \$12.00 per week. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Knost moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that L. F. Sanford be re-employed for 1963 as Sharon Township Fire Department Fire Chief, and that his compensation be set \$660.00 per month, payable on the 1st and 15th. All voted "aye" thereon.

Fire Department Custodians compensation was set.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Knost that Phillip L. Thomas be appointed as Assistant Fire Chief and be compensated \$560.00 per month, \$100.00 As Assistant Chief and \$460.00 as Custodian.

That: Stanley Shultz be re-employed as Fire House Custodian under the direction of the Fire Chief and that his compensation be set at \$445.00 per month, payable on the 1st and 15th.

That: A. E. Wilson be re-employed as Fire House Custodian under the direction of the Fire Chief and that his compensation be set at \$430.00 per month, payable on the 1st and 15th.

- A. Each employee shall be allowed .3 (3/10) days sick leave at full pay for each completed week of service, the maximum accumulation for a year (12 months) being 15.6 per work weeks, per year. At no time shall the accumulation exceed 90 days.
- B. An employee may be allowed leave with pay for not more than five days per year for illness in his immediate family. Such leave shall be charged against the accumulated sick leave of any such employee. Illness in the immediate family shall be defined as illness of husband, wife, son, daughter, father, mother, or any other relative living in the home of the employee.
- C. An employee may be allowed leave with pay for not to exceed three work days for death of any relative or of any person living in the home of the employee. Such leave shall be charged against the accumulated sick leave of any such employee.
- D. When an employee is absent for any reason, a certified report for such absence, signed by his superior (Fire Chief - and or Trustee) shall be completed by an such employee on a form supplied by the Sharon Township Clerk and shall be filed with the Clerk in not less than 15 days following the last day of such absence.
 1. When an employee is absent formore than three days as a result of personal illness, a doctor's certificate on a form to be supplied by the Township Clerk, in addition to the above certified record shall be filed with the clerk, in not less that 15 days following the last day of such absence.
 2. An employee shall not be required to swear to such certified record but the signing and filing of such record by any employee shall be certification by him that the facts and statements contained in said report are true and correct, and the filing of any wilfully false statement by an employee shall be considered by the Trustees as grounds for such disciplinary action as the Trustees may deem advisable
