The first meeting of the year 1966 was called to order by the township clerk.

RESOLUTION 1-1966

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio:

That, Orban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance be re-employed and designated as Police Constables for Sharon Township.

The compensation of Constable Barker to be set at \$384.00 per month, \$4,608.00 per year, payable on the 1st and 15th of each month for keeping the peace and protecting the property and performing the duties as a police constable, to have a two weeks vacation with pay, and have a \$1,000.00 Police Constable Bond and Carry of Arms Bond, that radio maintenance and the purchase of uniforms be paid by the township subject to review and approval from the board.

- I. Absence and Sick Leave
 - A. Each employee shall be allowed ^{.03} 3/10 days sick leave at full pay for each completed week of service, the ^{1.3 mo} maximum accumulation for a year being 15.6 days. At no time shall the accumulation exceed 90 days.
 - B. An employee may be allowed leave with pay for not more than five days per year for illness in his immediately family. Such leave shall be charges against the accumulated sick leave of any such employee. Illness in the immediate family shall be defined as illness of wife, son, daughter, mother or father, or any other relative living in the house of the employee.
 - C. An employee may be allowed leave with pay for not to exceed three work days for death of any relative or of any person living in the home of the employee. Such leave shall be charged against the accumulated sick leave of any such employee.

- D. When an employee is absent for any reason, a certified report for such absence, signed by his superior (Fire Chief or Trustee) shall be completed by the employee on a form supplied by the clerk and shall be filed with the clerk in not less than 15 days (fifteen) following the last day of such absence.
1. When an employee is absent for more than three days as a result of personal illness, a doctor's certificate on a form to be supplied by the clerk, in addition to the above certified record shall be filed with the clerk, in not less than 15 days following the last day of such absence.
 2. An employee shall not be required to swear to such certified record but the signing and filing of such record by any employee shall be certification by him that the facts and statements contained in said report are true and correct, and the filing of any willfully false statement by an employee shall be considered as grounds for such disciplinary action as the Trustees may deem advisable.

Mr. Loomis introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption.

RESOLUTION 3- 1966

Whereas The Sharon Township Fire Department have held Mutual Aid Contracts with various political sub-division surrounding Sharon Township, and

Whereas under Substitute House Bill No. 546 of the General Assembly of the State of Ohio made such contracts no longer necessary for the fire department to be protected under the Sections 701.02, 717.021, 4123.01 & 4123.94 when acting outside the township boundaries, and ,

Whereas, participation and coverage under the above section become mandatory upon authorization of the Board of Township Trustees,

Therefore, be it Resolved, That such authorization be granted to cover the following political subdivisions. Columbus, (Montgomery Township) Perry, Washington, Clinton Mifflin, Plain, Westerville and Blendon Townships in Franklin County and Orange and Liberty Townships in Delaware County, for the purpose of rendering secondary fire protection at the discretion of the Sharon Township Fire Chief or his duly authorized person in charge.

Mr. Knost seconded the above Resolution, all Voted "Aye" thereon.

(Orange Township - Delaware County Ohio agreement expires 4-21-1968)

Total nine hours nightly, 7 days a week 364 days a year (Exception Christaas Eve) This would allow men to spend early evening hours at home and be on station during sleeping hours only. By having two men on duty at firehouse, approximately a 3-4 minute delay in answering squad calls could be avoided, making service immediate. On fire calls, squad men would comprise first two men of pump or truck crew as case may be thereby enabling equipment to roll upon arrival of first two men rather than first four or five men. Squad men would be chosen from present units with addition of two men not used in the past due to their excessive distances from firehouse. This increase would enable us to have five units rather than existing four. Suggested pay rate for this duty would be .85¢ perhour or \$7.65 per man per nine hour period plus normal volunteer pay for any and all runs made during duty hours. Total for year would be \$5,569.20 over and above what would normally be expended. This would give the township the equivelent of two additional highly experienced men, working 63 hours a week for total of \$2,784.60 each per year. Only additional equipment township would purchase would consist of three roll-a-way beds at approx. cost of \$45.00 each.

Trustees, Fire Chief and Captain Loos discussed this proposal were pleased to hear the presentation. No discission was made at this date.


