The first meeting of the year 1964 was called to order by the township clerk.

The December 18th and 30th minutes were read and approved.

Clerk asked for nominations for 1964 Chairman and Vice-Chairman. Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Carl O. Knost serve as Chairman of the Sharon Township Trustees Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Knost that John D. Loomis serve as Vice-Chairman of the Sharon Township Trustees Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Trustees Set the first and third Wednesday night of each month at Sharon Township Hall, time 7:30 P.M. as the regular meeting nights.

The Ohio State Convention of Township Trustees and Clerks will be held January 22, 23, 24, 25 1964, Columbus, Ohio. Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that all expenses to and from and during the convention plus garage expenses be paid. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Merlin T. Denig be redesignated as Sharon Township Road Superintendent and Flint Cemetery Superintendent, and that his compensation be set at \$70.00 per week for his duties as said superintendent. (\$140.00 per month charged to Flint Cemetery and \$140.00 per month charged to the Gas Tax Fund) Mr. Denigs bond to be set at \$1,000.00; that he be authorized to employ such help as he may deem necessary, that the same be compensated at a rate set by him not to exceed \$2.50 per hour, however any raise above \$2.00 must have the approval of the board. ## Sharon Township Full Firemen regulations, etc.

- A. Paid men when on duty at the fire house are under supervision of the Fire Chief.
- B. Classification will be Firemen: under Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund (48)
- C. Full time Firemen to do misc. work, paint, wash walls, clean after emergency runs and fire runs, change oil, grease fire truck etc.
- D. Volunteer calls after hours are to be paid same as other volunteer firemen except for Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief.
- E. Hours Scheduled 7:30 to 4:30 Monday thru Friday  
7:30 to 12:00 Saturday
- F. Vacation: Two weeks vacation after one year of service, not accumulative; with the following legal holidays off:
  1. New Years Day
  2. Memorial Day
  3. July 4th
  4. Labor Day
  5. Thanksgiving Day
  6. Christmas Day.
- (Firemen, Eustodian, Police, Cemetery & Road Crew)
- G. Work clothes to be alkies for all firemen.
- H. Men must present a neat appearance to public at all times.
- I. Absence & Sick Leave.

- A. Each employee shall be allowed (Firemen) .3 (3/10) days sick leave at full pay for each completed week or service, the maximum accumulation for a year (12 months) being 15.6 per work weeks, per year. At no time shall the accumulation exceed 90 days.
- B. An employee may be allowed leave with pay for not more than five day per year for illness in his immediate family. Such leave shall be charged against the accumulated sick leave of any such employee. Illness in the immediate family shall be defined as illness of husband, wife, son, daughter, father, mother or any other relative living in the home of the employee.
- C. An employee may be allowed leave with pay for not to exceed three work days for death of any relative or of any person living in the home of the employee. Such leave shall be charged against the accumulated sick leave of any such employee.
- D. When an employee is absent for any reason, a certified report for such absence, signed by his superior (Fire Chief and or Trustee) shall be completed by an such employee on a form supplied by the Sharon Township Clerk and shall be filed with the Clerk in not less than 15 days following the last day of such absence.
  1. When an employee is absent for more than three days as a result of personal illness, a doctor's certificate on a form to be supplies by the Township Clerk, in addition to the above certified record shall be filed with the clerk, in not less than 15 days following the last day of such absence.
  2. An employee shall not be required to swear to such certified record but the signing and filing of such record by any employee shall be certification by him that the facts and statements contained in said report are true and correct, and the filing of any wilfully false statement by an employee shall be considered as grounds for such disciplinary action as the Trustees may deem advisable

Mr. Thomas Sutphen, from Sutphens Fire Equipment appeared before the board and discussed fire trucks and equipment.

The January 1st minutes were re-read, January 15th minutes read and approved.

Clerk submitted the Walnut Grove Cemetery Association Report of the Secretary-Treasurer for the Calendar Year 1963; Report of the Mausoleum Funds, Walnut Grove Cemetery for the Calendar Year 1963 by M.
