The December 18th and December 28th minutes were re-read and January 4, 1969 read and approved.

Clerk submitted the 1968 Financial and Operating Fund Statement, the Worthington Savings Bank Statement as of January 1, 1969.

Assistant Fire Chief reported on all fire department matters, stated that the Chief would be back from vacation at the end of the week.

Reappointments are in order. Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Wing that they be re-appointed to serve on the Sharon Memorial Board. All voted "Aye" thereon.



The following were present: Trustees, Carl O. Knost, John D. Loomis, George V. Wing; Clerk, Eleanor A. Bierly; Fire Chief, L. F. Sanford, Assistant Fire Chief, Phillip L. Thomas; Constables, Orban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance.

Mr. Scanlon and Mr. Lock appeared before the board to discuss the Continental Casualty major medical policy. L.F. Sanford asked about the heart, cancer qualified condition of his policy. He is to check with doctor regarding his information. Eleanor Bierly asked about the weight listed - which had not been filled in prior to signing, about insurance cancellation, about being refused by other companies, Mr. Scanlon and Mr. Lock agreed that her policy was correct. Mr. Sanford asked about nervous disorders etc. and about a 36 month time waiver for another fireman. Life insurance restriction from 5,000.00 to \$10,000.00 were discussed.

Mr. John D. Loomis moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Sharon Township Franklin County, Ohio; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Township Trustees of the Township of Sharon, Franklin County, Ohio two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy an increase of (o.f) mill (1/2 of 1 mil) tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Sharon Township for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, building or sites therefor, payment of permanent, part-time volunteer firemen at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the question of levying such tax in excess of such limitation be submitted to the electors of said subdivision May 6, 1969 Primary Election at the usual places in said subdivision of the 6th of May 1969, and be it further

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax lists of the duplicate year next succeeding the election if 55% of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this board Sharon Township Trustees be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Franklin County, Ohio immediately after its passage, and notify said board of elections to cause notice of questions of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

Mr. George V. Wing seconded the Resolution and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows.



Clerk submitted the Operating Fund Statement as of February 1, 1969, the Worthington Savings Bank Statement.

City of Columbus Development Commission, Zoning Administrator Division of Zoning letter was received. Public Hearing is scheduled February 13, 1969 for zoning a tract of land on the west side of Maple Canyon Avenue.

Fire Chief reported on all fire department matters.

It was discussed at the volunteer firmens meeting to collect fees twice a year June 1 and December 1 of each year. Fire Chief presented this to the trustees. SHERI-LOU NURSING HOME, SLATED FOR EVACUATION MONDAY

Evacuation Ordered For Nursing Home

Twenty residents of the Sheri-Lou Nursing home, 8200 N. High St., were slated to be evacuated Monday, by order of the Sharon Township Fire Department.

Supported by the Ohio Department of Health, the evacuation decision was reached Monday by township fire inspectors after Fire Chief Louis Sanford ordered home operators to either fix an undercut dirt bridge or face evacuation within 12 hours.

AT MID-MORNING, HOME personnel said residents could be placed in other nursing homes, but plans were still tentative.

Sanford's 12-hour deadline was given after Carl Knost, chairman of the township's board of trustees, discovered Sunday that a portion of the bridge, on a private road, had been washed out, presumably by the rainstorm which struck northern suburbs Friday afternoon.

An attempt by Robert Ricketts, president of Sheri-Lou Nursing Home, Inc., to fix the bridge Monday morning, was judged insufficient by township fire inspectors, Lts. A. R. Wilson and Alan Hitepole, and Bob Kauer of the health department.

EDWARD FORD OF McKinley Trucking Co. Monday morning delivered 21 tons of rock to be pushed into the washout by a tractor.

However, Wilson said the fill would not be adequate. He and Knost cited deficiencies such as the stream pipe under the dirt-packed crossing being too short, thus allowing water to undercut, and softness on the other side, indicated by a deep hole gouged in the road by the dump truck.

"If there'd have been a fire here last night, I wouldn't have let the fire trucks go in," said Knost, citing the poor condition of the bridge. The department's biggest truck weighs 17 tons.

"THE WHOLE thing will have to be dug out," he said. "And the winding road should be straightened for easier access."

Wilson said even before the dirt bridge was undercut, the road was considered a hazard because fire vehicles had to drive too slowly in getting to the area of the nursing home. Another house and two trailers are near the nursing home.

Knost's major complaint was that the drainage pipe under the dirt bridge is too short, "It should extend eight feet beyond instead of ending under the bridge," he said.

THE PIPE CARRIES water from one side of the ravine to the other, but presently it seeps out underneath the dirt bridge, he said.

After examining the dirt bridge and the new rock, Wilson said since it was insufficient and it would therefore be impossible for the bridge to be repaired properly in the remaining time, the evacuation order would be enforced.

Kauer, supervising sanitarium and certification officer for Medicaid, said he would back the fire department's decision.

Samuel Fraley, health department licensure officer, said the home's permanent license was renewed June 2 after two complaints about safety were dismissed when the hazards were corrected.

He said the home is licensed to house 20 persons, 13 ambulatory on the second floor and seven, all bedridden, on the first.

Nursing Home Wins Reprieve

The Sheri-Lou Nursing home, 8200 N. High St., got a temporary reprieve Tuesday.

The threatened evacuation of the home, by order of the Sharon Township Fire Department, was postponed at midday after fire inspectors A. R. Wilson and Alan Hittepole met with assistant county prosecutors Tommy L. Thompson and James O'Grady.

THOMPSON SAID he had advised the Sharon Township board of trustees and the fire department to issue a new order granting a reasonable time for the home to comply with the department's order that an earthen bridge be reinforced to make it safe for fire trucks to cross.

No time limit was specified. Thompson said part of the bridge was washed out last Friday. It was an engineering problem and should be worked out between the department and Robert Ricketts, manager of Sheri-Lou, which houses 19 residents, five or six of whom are bedridden.

MEANWHILE, Ricketts brought in a road engineer from the Schuette Construction Company of Powell, Ohio, who said Tuesday that the repaired bridge "is safe for anything to cross it."

Fire inspectors had stated they would request ambulances remove the patients, but, by Tuesday, Ricketts had hired Columbus attorney Roger Stridsberg to fight the evacuation order.

THE ISSUE CAME to a head Monday after Sharon Township Fire Chief Louis Sanford issued a 12-hour repair or evacuate order. Sanford examined the dirt bridge Sunday and declared it unsafe for fire vehicles because of the washout.

The 12:45 p.m. Monday repair deadline found fire inspectors refusing to accept Ricketts' attempts to repair the bridge as satisfactory.

Carl Knost, chairman of the township's board of trustees and the discoverer of the washout, said Monday, "If there'd been a fire here last night, I wouldn't have let the fire trucks cross the bridge."

KNOST AND WILSON said the ravine-spanning bridge was unsafe because one side is held only by four small elms and because too short a drain pipe causes seepage and undercutting.

The fire department action culminated a series of events including items such as snow not being removed from the private road in the winter and the difficulty of maneuvering fire engines on the winding road in answer to alarms.

"I've spent \$500 fixing this road," Ricketts said Monday. "I've got gravel in. It has been bulldozed, but I'm no miracle worker. I've seen state highways near Lake Erie washed out worse than this. How can they expect me to build a better road than the state?"






