Held..... Special Meeting January 1, 1959

The following were present: Trustees, John D. Loomis, Earl B. Smith, Melvin L. Thomas; Clerk, Eleanor A. Bierly; Constable Norman C. Severance.

The first meeting of the year 1959 was called to order by the township clerk.

The clerk asked for nominations from the floor for the Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

Mr. Thomas nominated Mr. Loomis as Chairman and Mr. Smith as Vice-Chairman and moved that the nominations be closed and that the clerk be instructed to cast an unanimous vote for each nominee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Smith and carried. All voted "aye" thereon.

Trustees set the first and third Wednesday of each month at Sharon Township Hall, time 7:30 P.M. as regular meeting nights.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that Merlin T. Denig be redesignated as the Sharon Township Road Superintendent and Flint Cemetery Superintendent, and that his compensation be set at \$55.00 per week for his duties (\$27.50 Gas Tax-\$27.50 Flint Cemetery) as superintendent. Mr. Denig's bond to be set at \$1,000.00 that Mr. Denig be authorized to employ such help as he may deem necessary and that the same be compensated at a rate set by said superintendent not to exceed \$1.75 per hour. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that Harold A. Morgan be re-employed for 1959, as the Sharon Township Fire Station Custodian, that the custodian be compensated \$225.00 per month; payable 1st and 15th of each month; that he have two weeks vacation with pay, that the custodian obtain a reliable person to take charge during this two week vacation period; ^{at \$100.00} that he employ the custodian relief one day a week not to exceed \$10.00 per week. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved seconded by Mr. Smith that Mr. Lawrence C. Brown be re-appointed as Sharon Township Fire Chief for 1959 that his compensation be set at \$150.00 per month. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Smith moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that the Fire and emergency run compensation for the fiscal year 1959 be as follows \$3.00 for the 1st hour or fraction thereof
1.00 for the 2nd hour or fraction thereof
2.00 for the 3rd hour and any other or fraction thereof. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Smith moved, Seconded by Mr. Loomis that the compensation for the township clerk be set at \$500.00 base, plus 2% of all expenditures in the excess of \$5,000.00, not to exceed \$2,400.00 for the fiscal year 1959. That the \$1,000.00 renewal bond be paid at \$10.00. All voted "aye" thereon.

Chairman Loomis asked Mr. Thomas to continue scheduling the use of the township hall when requested and when it is necessary.

Clerk reported that the following reported had been received from the County auditor for completion. RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio:

That Orban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance be re-employed and designated as Police Constables for Sharon Township.

That the compensation of Constable Orban J. Barker be set at \$175.00 per month payable on the 1st and 15th of each month for the performance of his duties as Sharon Township Police Constable keeping the peace and protecting the property and performing the duties as a police constable, provide and maintain a police cruiser at his own expense, and shall be available for calls, and have a \$1,000.00 Police Constable Bond.

That Constable Severance be compensation be set at \$3.75 per call answered, in his performance of his duties as Sharon Township Police Constable and have a \$1,000.00 Bond - Police Constable Bond.

Mr. Thomas seconded the Resolution. All voted "aye" thereon.





A letter was received from the Franklin County Budget Commission regarding the Local Government Fund Distribution. Sharon Township will receive \$2,500.00. In view of this letter Chairman of the Board of Trustees introduced the following resolution.

RESOLUTION

Whereas Sharon Township Trustees have found they cannot hire sufficient day time volunteer firemen to adequately protect the property and life of the township taxpayers, and

Whereas this situation developed after the 1959 Budget was submitted to the Budget Commission, and

Whereas as the only solution appears to hire (2) two full time day firemen at an estimated cost of \$10,000.00, and

Whereas the situation was pointed out at the Budget Commission hearing on the distribution of the Local Government Fund with an accompanying request for the \$10,000.00 needed, and

Whereas the secretary of the Budget Commission has notified us that \$2,500.00 (the same amount received 1958- and needed to meet the 1959 Budget submitted in May of 1958) is the amount of the Local Government money allocated to Sharon Township for 1959, and

Whereas the City of Columbus which ended the 1958 year with a \$2,000,000.00 surplus is to receive \$1,500,000.00 from the Local Government Fund (An increase of \$95,000.00 over the 1958 allocation.)

Whereas bylaw Local Government Fund money is to be distributed according to need and,

Whereas, the need of Sharon Township was ignored and the questionable need of Columbus was rewarded by the Budget Commission,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Sharon Township Clerk be instructed to make an appointment for the Sharon Township Trustees with the County Prosecutor to discuss litigation to be taken to appeal the decision of the Budget Commission.

Mr. Earl P. Smith seconded the resolution and roll being called the vote resulted as follows: Mr. Loomis "aye," Mr. Smith "aye," Mr. Thomas "aye."

Constables Urban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance submitted police reports and reported on all calls.



January 7th, 1959 minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Loomis reported that he had check regarding the Animal Claim submitted by Mr. Shapter and found out that as soon as Columbus annexes any territory they are responsible for the payment of these claims in annexed areas. Mr. Wade Farm manager was informed and picked up the forms and dog warden report and submitted the claim to the City Clerk of Columbus Council.

The Franklin County Regional Planning Commission's Annual report was received and viewed by the trustees.

Clerk reported that Road Supt. Denig had reported that the flood damage to the township road would be over \$2,000.00. Clerk wrote a letter to the Civil Defense stating such.

Mt. Air Developer, Dale Stump asked the trustees about fixing two of the undeveloped roads- Cherry Tree and Apple Tree Drives to Mt. Air Standards rather than County Standards. Clerk to write to Prosecuting Attorney regarding this. Current practice is for the County Engineers to inspect a new road and then notify county Commissioner who then notify the township to maintain them.

Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources Form A-37-3 was received from the Budget Commission.

Fire CHIEF Brown asked trustees about hiring persons in the 18-21 age group. Clerk is to write Prosecuting Attorney regarding the township liability for hiring minors 18-21 as volunteer fire men, squad men and road work men.

Mr. Smith was asked to check on Flood damage claim, thru Sgt. Martin, County Sheriff, Civil Defense for the following streets, Westview, Rosslyn, Kanawha, Beech Drive, Edgecliff, Milton and Riverside Drive.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that the Resolution accepting the amount and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certify them to the Count Auditor be accepted. Form #3011 All voted "aye" thereon.

Fire Chief Brown reported on all fire and emergency runs and fire department matters, and flood work. Trustees thank him for such wonderful service during this emergency.

Fire Chief Brown reported that Richard B. Morgan had turned in his resignation as a regular fireman and is now on the reserve fireman list.

Fire Chief Brown reported that Bill Snouffer had turned in his resignation as a regular fireman and is now on the reserve fireman list as of January 13, 1959. Both of these men have been the best of firemen and trustees express appreciation for their faithful and loyal service during the past 15-20 yrs.

Fire Chief Brown requested the need of stationary at the fire house and request was granted to purchase needed paper.

Mr. Smith reported that He and Mr. Loomis and Clerk Bierly had attended some of the January Conventinn lectures.

Clerk wrote a letter to the Worthington Motor Ford for Constable Barker authorizing him to purchase a police interceptor at his expense.
