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

The following were present: Trustees, John D. Loomis, Earl B. Smith, Melvin L. Thomas; Clerk, Eleanor McMannus, Road Superintendent & Flint Cemetery Superintendent, Merlin T. Denig; Fire Chief, L. C. Brown; Constables, Orban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance.

The first meeting of the year 1958 was called to order by the Township Clerk.

The clerk asked for nominations from the floor for the Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

Mr. Smith nominated Mr. Thomas as Chairman and Mr. Loomis as Vice-Chairman and moved that the nominations be closed and that the clerk be instructed to cast an unanimous vote for each nominee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Loomis and carried. All voted "Aye" thereon.

The minutes of the December 18th meeting were read and approved as read.

The trustees set the first and third Wednesday of each month at Sharon Township Hall, at 8:00 P.M., as the regular meeting nights.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Merlin T. Denig be redesignated and re-employed as the Sharon Township Road Superintendent and Flint Cemetery Superintendent. All vote "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that the compensation of Merlin T. Denig be set at \$50.00 per week for the fiscal year of 1958, for the time spent in the performance of his duties and that Mr. Denig's bond be set at \$1,000.00. Compensation for Road Superintendent \$25.00 per week, Compensation for Flint Cemetery Superintendent \$25.00 per week. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Mr. Denig be authorized to employ such assistance as he may deem necessary and that the same be compensated at a rate set by said superintendent not to exceed \$1.75 per hour.

Mr. Denig reported on all Road Maintenance work and Flint Cemetery work.

Mr. Denig discussed the need of using some drain tile at Flint cemetery. Trustees authorized him to proceed with the necessary drain tiling.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Harold A. Morgan, Fire House Custodian be re-employed for 1958, that the custodian be compensated \$200.00 per month; that he have two weeks vacation with pay, that the custodian obtain a reliable person to take charge during this two week vacation time at \$87.50, and that he employ custodian relief one day a week not to exceed \$36.00 per month in cost. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Lawrence C. Brown be re-appointed as Sharon Township Fire Chief; that his compensation be set at \$100.00 per month for the fiscal year 1958 for time spent in the performance of his Fire Chief duties. Motion carried, All voted "Aye" thereon.

Fire Chief submitted the December fire and emergency squad reports, reports were placed on file.

Gas Tax Money can be used for purchasing Road Equipment. (#5735.27 & #5549.21) Ohio Revised Code.

2. Mr. Martin Vince, Head Supervisor of the State Auditing Staff for Townships stated that Gas Tax Moneys can be used for Road Construction, maintenance, repair and purchase of machinery and equipment.

3. Mr. Allison: Right of way- Set Back of Shrubs Stated that trustees have the right to control any planting in the road right of way.

Mr. Koerner, County Engineer's office stated that Rosslyn Avenue has a 50 foot right-away and that it is a 26 foot street, therefore, Trustees can control 12 foot from back of curb. Ray Hickey, Franklin County Zoning Department, stated that the County Commissioners resolved that shrubs must not be more than 3 foot max. height to building set back and not shruberry to 25ft. set back on corner lots and further resolved that no hedge or fence in residential areas can be more than 75% solid or over 3ft. in height.

Mr. Hickey recommends that the property owners on Rosslyn whos shrub block the view from driveways be contacted and advised on the above rulings. If they do not correct the situation trustees can then notify the County Zoning Board of the violation and they will force the property owners to conform.


