The following were present: Trustees, Warren E. Insley, John D. Loomis, Melvin L. Thomas; Clerk, Eleanor McMannus, Road Superintendent & Flint Cemetery Superintendent, Merlin T. Denig; Fire Chief, L. C. Brown; Constables, Orban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance.

The first meeting of 1957 was called to order by the Township Clerk.

The clerk asked for nominations for the Chairman and for Vice-Chairman.

Mr. Loomis nominated Mr. Insley as Chairman and Mr. Thomas as Vice-Chairman, and moved that the nominations be closed and the Clerk instructed to cast an unanimous vote fore each nominee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Thomas and carried. All voted "aye" thereon.

Minutes of the December 31, 1956 meeting were read and approved.

The trustees set the first and third Wednesday of each month at Sharon Township Hall at 8:00 P.M. as the meeting nights.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Merlin T. Denig be redesignated and re-employed as Flint Cemetery Superintendent and Sharon Township Road Superintendent. All voted "aye."

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that the compensation of Merlin T. Denig be set at \$50.00 per week for the fiscal year 1957, for the time spent in the performance of his duties, and that Mr. Denig's bond be set at ~~\$200.00~~ ^{1,000.00}. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Road Superintendent be authorized to employ such assistance as he may deem necessary and that the same be compensated at a rate set by said superintendent not to exceed \$1.75 per hour for a foreman and \$1.50 per hour for other help. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that the Trustees designate the following sale price for graves at the Flint Cemetery as of February 1, 1957.

5 Grave Lot	\$75.00	Township Residents
1 Grave Space	15.00	Township Residents
5 Grave Lot	100.00	Outside Township residents
1 grave space	20.00	Outside Township residents

That the charge for opening and closing a grave be set at a fee of \$35.00.

That the Superintendent designate a plot for township indigent residents and price charged are to be \$25.00 for opening and closing a grave. \$15.00 for grave space. All voted "aye" thereon.

Trustees reported that effective 1-1-1957 all of South Sharon except, Sharon Springs, West view, West Kanawha and Rosslyn was annexed to the City of Columbus, that the trustees advised by the Prosecuting Attorney's opinion that upon such acceptance all obligations and duties of the Township to furnish services of any kind to said areas are severed and that all obligations to furnish services passes to Columbus upon the passage of the Ordinance accepting the annexing territory.

Trustees reported that Road Superintendent was instructed to terminate all road services, Fire Chief instructed to terminate all fire and emergency services to said areas except such as might be required under the Columbus and Sharon Township Mutual Aid Contract.

Mr. Insley reported that he would receive an opinion from the County Prosecuting Attorney regarding the purchase of uniforms for regular firemen who are members of the Emergency Squad.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Harold A. Morgan, Fire House Custodian be re-employed for 1957, that compensation be set at \$200.00 per month; that he have two weeks vacation with pay; that custodian obtain a reliable person to take charge during the two week vacation time at \$87.50; and that he employee custodian relief one day per week not to exceed \$36.00 per month. All voted "Aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Lawrence C. Brown be re-appointed as Sharon Township Fire Chief; that his compensation be set at \$100.00 per month for the fiscal year 1957 for time spent in the performance of his duties. Motion carried. All voted "aye" thereon.

Fire Chief Brown submitted the Fire and Emergency Squad Reports, and runs were discussed. Reports were places on file. Fire Department matters were discussed. It was agreed to request the Prosecuting Attorney for an opinion regarding the liability of trustees and firemen in case of accident outside the township territory.

Mr. Thomas introduced the following resolution and moved it adoption:

RESOLUTION:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio.

Section I: That Orban J. Barker and Norman Severance be re-employed and designated as Police Constables of Sharon Township;

Section II: That the compensation of Constable Barker be set at \$300.00 per month until March 31, 1957 for the performance of his duties as Sharon Township Constable, provided, however, that said Constable shall provide a police cruiser at his own expense and shall spend at least eight (3) hours per day in patrolling roads, keeping the peace and protecting property; that Constable Severance compensation be set at \$3.50 per call answered in his performance of his duties as Police Constable until March 31, 1957.

Mr. Loomis seconded the Resolution, All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that compensation for the Township Clerk be set at \$500.00 base, 2% of all expenditures in excess of \$5,000.00 not to exceed \$2,400.00 for 1957. That the \$1,000.00 Renewal Bond be paid at \$10.00. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Board of Trustees, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1957, the following sums be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during the said fiscal year, as follows, viz:

Trustees Order Check On Local Water Pressure

Following a recent announcement by the Worthington Board of Public Affairs that water pressure will be low during the summer months, the Sharon Township Trustees have ordered Fire Chief L. C. Brown to make a check of the amount of pressure and flow of water at all Worthington fire hydrants.

At their meeting Tuesday night, the trustees authorized the immediate purchase of the necessary engines to check the pressure and flow at fire hydrants and Fire Chief Brown will begin the work as soon as possible.

His report will be submitted both to the township trustees and to the Worthington city council.

Worthington, Riverlea and Sharon Township fire protection will be considerably increased within the next few weeks when delivery of a new aerial ladder fire truck is expected.

Fire and emergency protection for this community is furnished by the Sharon Township Volunteer Fire Department, the engine house being located on High Street just north of the Worthington municipal building.

Township to Elect Two Trustees and Two Constables

Sharon Township voters will elect two township trustees and two township constables at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 5.

The terms of trustees Melvin Thomas and Warren Insley and Constables O. J. Barker and Norman Severance will expire at the end of this year.

Constables Barker and Severance will seek re-election and Trustee Thomas has announced that he will be a candidate for re-election. Trustee Insley will not be a candidate.

Since Worthington and Riverlea are within Sharon Township, voters in these two municipalities vote on all township candidates and issues.

Township trustees and constables hold office for four years.

Sharon Township has three trustees, the third position being held by John D. Loomis. Mrs. Eleanor McMannus is the township clerk. The term of office of Mr. Loomis and Mrs. McMannus runs through 1959.
