Mr. Loomis moved that Merlin Denig be appointed township highway superintendent, that his compensation as such be designated at \$1.25 per hour for the time actually spent in the discharge of such duties, and that he be authorized to employ such additional labor as is necessary, to be paid for at the rate of \$1.25 per hour, ~~and that he be designated as highway superintendent~~
