The Clerk was instructed to obtain correct procedure for paying repair bill on tractor owned by Cemetery Board & operated by township.

Constable Berkers new auto insurance policy was received & found inadequate due to a restricting rider making the policy null & void, when the auto was driven under emergency conditions. Mr Loomis contacted the Reiger Ins. agency, for definition of emergency conditions & for coverage the agency could write for all conditions. Mr Reiger promised to have an answer on July 16th.

Mr Brown, fire chief, was present & discussed with Trustees the service limits of fire dept. The Trustees concurred with his decision to restrict service to the township, except where mutual aid contracts exist or in case of a national catastrophe.

at a special meeting held on July 29-53. Mr Loomis, Mr Dusley & Mr Thomas were present, fire chief Brown, Elmer Snauffer & asst chief Brattin were also present. to discuss the Civilian defense contribution to purchase a new pumper & accessories. Chief Brown reported that both applications (1 for pumper & 1 for equipment) had been approved & money was available to township upon presentation of vouchers. The breakdown of federal contributions is as follows: - \$5700.00 for pumper, light plant & pump to be purchased by government \$554.50 - balance of equipment to be purchased locally: \$563.75. This makes a total of \$7500.00 - \$73.45 to be contributed by federal government. Since less than one thousand dollars of equipment is to be purchased locally, it was resolved by the trustees that purchase of said equipment be made by fire chief, providing the vendor certifies the products to meet standard specifications in federal government manual F.C.D-146-I. The Board further authorized the chief to purchase a folding door for fire station, to decrease heating costs - to cost not more than \$72.00. The Board authorized the chief to purchase one davenport at \$135.00 & 6 chairs - not to exceed \$120.00. Painting the exterior of the fire house was discussed & chief submitted 2 bids of \$100, which included painting only east side of building & \$375, including all outside painting & caulking. There was some question as to whether \$100 - included painting the roof trim on east side & the matter was tabled for more definite information. The chief was instructed to install some sort of weather protection at bottom of fire doors, providing it did not exceed \$10.00.

That, if a majority of the residents of any un-incorporated area in Sharon Township of reasonable size and containing a reasonable number of residents therein desire to remain in their present un-incorporated status, or desire to annex territory to the Village of Worthington, or desire to form a separate municipal corporation, the township trustees voice no objection to or encouragement of such action, but will continue to provide the best possible township-trustee government for such portion of Sharon Township as chooses to be so governed."
