The meeting was called for the purpose of organizing for the year 1947.

The Deputy Clerk called the meeting to order, and asked for nominations for the office of President of the Board for the ensuing year.

Mr. Thomas nominated Mr. Schrock and moved that the nominations be closed and that the Clerk be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot for Mr. Schrock.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Schrock, and carried, Mr. Thomas and Mr. Schrock voting "yes" on roll call.

Mr. Schrock was declared elected president.

Mr. Schrock offered the following resolution, and moved its adoption:

"RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

WHEREAS, This Board of Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1st, 1947; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Board together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Board, and what part thereof is without, and what part within, the ten mill tax limitation; therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, that the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification be and the same are hereby accepted; and be it further

RESOLVED, By the Board of Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Township the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows:

The minutes of the meetings held December 31, 1946 and January 1st, 1947 were read and approved with the following exception:

Mr. Thomas moved that the minutes of the meeting held January 1st, 1947, be amended to include the following:- "That the regular meetings of the Trustees during 1947 be held on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of each month at 8 P. M. in the Office of the Trustees, Township Hall, Worthington, Ohio." The motion was seconded by Mr. Schrock, and carried.

President Schrock turned the meeting over to Howard P. Linn, Senior Justice of the Peace in Sharon Township.

Mr. Linn announced that on December 18th, 1946, he received a letter from the Deputy Clerk advising him of the resignation of Trustee Jerry Ward. That since the appointment of a successor to Mr. Ward devolved upon him, he had seriously considered the qualifications of all who were suggested (25). Mr. Linn then points he considered in making his selection, and announced the appointment of Warren Insley as Sharon Township Trustee to complete the term Of Jerry Ward.






